Awards



1st through ?? place for teams (everyone will get a ribbon)



1st through 6th place for Horse Management.



1st through 3rd place for top individual scores per division

- An award for "Pony Club spirit" will be available for an individual exemplifying the Pony Club Pledge.

Chaperones



Chaperones must accompany each team and be on the grounds at all times.



Chaperones must read and sign the Uniform Chaperone Rules/Duties form. The signed form must be included with the team's entry form. Clearly PRINT the chaperone's name on the team entry form!



All child medications are to be administered by the Chaperone, not by Horse Management.



The chaperone must carry a current medical release form for each Pony Clubber for whom they are responsible.

Eligibility



The minimum age for all horses & ponies entered is five years based on birth date.



Horse used in this competition should be the participant's regular USPC mount, and be accustomed to being handled by it's rider without adult supervision. Note: A participant may use a mount other than their regular mount only with the advance permission of the DC and RS.



Any rating level can participate. Mixed ratings within teams allowed / encouraged.

Food



4 meal tickets are included with Entry fee. Concessions available for Tuesday and Wednesday Breakfast, Lunch and Supper, Thursday Breakfast and Lunch, and snacks all three days

Vet Check

Fairgrounds have the following health requirements:

Interstate health certificate *or* vet check upon arrival. Vet will be available Monday 6-8pm and Tuesday 8am to noon.

Horse temperature taken prior to shipping. **Do not bring horses that have a fever.**

Stabling



Stalls will be set up in an indoor area with concrete floors, please bring mats.



Each team will be assigned one stall per horse, one tack stall per team, and one feed stall per two teams if space is available (if no space, trailers will be used for tack and/or feed stalls).



Stabling is included –extra fee if checking in on Monday night or leaving on Thursday



Bedding is available for \$6 per bale



Stripping stalls into isle when finished.



Dogs are not allowed

Teams



Each team will consist of three (3) or four (4) riders, one of whom shall be designated as the team captain.



Any rating level can participate. Must be D-3 or higher to qualify for Championships 2008. Non-qualifying members are encouraged to participate.



Mixed ratings within teams are allowed / encouraged.

Scrambled Teams



If your club does not have a complete team, either call other clubs to make up a 'scrambled team', or send entries to be placed on scrambled teams by the Rally Organizer.

Divisions:

Divisions offered are based on competitor age as of **January 1, 2007**. Participants may compete at a lower jumping division with 200 points deducted per level lowered.



Senior (age > 15, C-1 or above) Run 3000M, swim 200M, max jumping 3'7", 20 shots at 10M



Junior (age 12-14, D-3 or above) Run 2000M, swim 200M, max jump 3'3", 20 shots at 10M



Intermediate (age ≥ 12, D-3 or above) Run 1000M, swim 100M, max jump 2'9", 20 shots at 10M



Novice (age ≤ 11, D-3 or above) Run 1000M, swim 100M, max jump 2'9", 20 shots at 10M



+Pre-Novice (age ≤ 11, D-2 or above) Run 500M, swim 50M, max jump 2'3", 10 shots at 10M



+10 and Under (age ≤ 10, D-1 or above) Run 500M, swim 50M, max jump 18", 10 shots at 10M



+8 and Under (age ≤ 8, D-1 or UR) Run 500M, swim 25M, max jump X-rails or poles, 10 shots at 5M



*** Fossil A (age > 25) Run 500M, swim 50M, max jump X-rails or poles, 10 shots at 10M



*** Fossil B (age > 25) same as A – scoring much more lenient



*** Sibfri A (Sibling/Friend) ages 15-25



*** Sibfri B ages 10-14



*** Sibfri C ages 5-9
